About the role:

Under the supervision of the Practice Lead Social Support and Managing Solicitor of the Alice Springs office, the Youth Support Case Worker provides individualised support and referral services to young people before the youth justice court, or involved with the civil service, to ensure they receive appropriate non-legal support services.

About you:

The position requires a self-motivated person who has experience working with young people. The applicant will require an understanding of the criminal justice system and how it relates to young people and will focus on information, support, and assistance. On-going training will be provided in relation to specific legal issues. The successful applicant will be confident in case planning, providing support to young people and families and will value working collaboratively in a team and with other agencies.
